SPRINGING FORWARD

Every year before Christmas and Easter, one congregation regularly designs and sends postcards all over town inviting people to its services. Last year's Easter card showed two versions of the same photograph side by side. A family carefully poses in front of a Christmas tree: perhaps grandparents, two daughters, and a grandchild. Hair styles and fashion place them in the early 1960s. The photo on the left—cracked, faded, peeling—is labeled "Damaged." The retouched photo on the right is labeled "Restored." Linking the two is a giant "#Easter."

What, besides the Christmas tree, is wrong with this picture?

If Easter is about turning back the clock, "we are of all people most to be pitied" (1 Cor. 15:19). Of course resurrection repairs the past, but not by pretending that damage never occurred. The glorified Christ bore wounds. So do we who have been buried and raised with him in baptism. Death no longer has dominion. Resurrection transforms us and the world into something new. We spring forward!

On the first Easter morning, the risen Christ tells Mary Magdalene, "Do not hold on to me . . . But go to my brothers and say to them, 'I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God'" (John 20:17). Christ is saying, "You will find me not where you did before, but in the community that bears my name."

The beginning of John's gospel promised that all who receive Christ are given the power to become children of God. Today's reading fulfills that promise. For the first time in the resurrection, Jesus uses the language of family: "my brothers." Like Naomi speaking to Ruth, he uses the language of covenant: "my God and your God." Cross and resurrection have formed a new family, a new people. With Mary Magdalene we see the risen Lord in the unretouched faces of sisters and brothers gathered from every nation to celebrate the joyous and everlasting feast.

GOOD FRIDAY SERVICE

This year's Good Friday Community Service will be held at Trinity United Methodist Church in Mifflin on Friday, April 19, 2019 at 12:00 Noon. The service will begin at the church, which

will be followed by a procession of the cross. Everyone is invited to attend this special Holy Week service.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Easter is not fixed to a specific day. It usually falls between March 22nd and April 25th. It is supposed to fall on the first Sunday after the full moon following March 21st.
- Easter is the oldest Christian holiday.
- Easter takes place on a Sunday, after the 40-day period called Lent. Lent is referred to as a time of fasting, but participants focus more on giving up one significant indulgence
- Decorating Easter eggs was traditionally a symbol of the empty tomb. This tradition is called Pysanka. Christians believe that Easter eggs symbolize new life and resurrection.
- The first Easter baskets looked like bird's nests.
- Eggs were a symbol of life to Ancient Egyptians, Persians, Romans and Greeks. The custom of giving eggs at Easter originated with them.
- The White House holds an annual Easter egg hunt on the front lawn. This tradition began in 1878 with President Rutherford B. Hayes.
- Approximately \$14.7 billion is spent every Easter, with an average of \$130 for each home. 120 million pounds of candy are sold at Easter. Approximately 75% of people will eat the chocolate bunny's ears first.
- Over 16 million jelly beans are eaten on Easter in the United States. This is enough jelly beans to circle the earth three times.
- Lilies are a flower often associated with Easter (Easter Lilies). The petals face downward, which is in honor of Jesus.
- Wearing new clothing on Easter is said to bring good luck for the coming year.
