### VICOR'S FEBRUARY MESSAGE

Dear Messiah Family,

As we are well into the season of Epiphany, let us look at the start of this season, then to the closing. On the first Sunday after Epiphany we always celebrate the Baptism of our Lord. This year our acolytes used seashells to lift up and continuously pour water in the Baptismal Font while the congregation shared the Confession and Forgiveness of Sins. In this manner we celebrate the ongoing Baptism of Jesus and all of God's children as members of the church on earth and in heaven. The Gospel for that Sunday included Matthew 3:17. "And a voice from heaven said, "*This is my Son*, the Beloved, with whom *I* am well pleased." (NRSV)

On the last Sunday after Epiphany, before Ash Wednesday, we celebrate the Transfiguration of Jesus. This year, that Sunday is February 23. The Gospel that day includes Matthew 17:5. While he was still speaking, suddenly a bright cloud overshadowed them, and from the cloud a voice said, "This is my Son, the Beloved; with him I am well pleased; listen to him!" (NRSV). These two events in the ministry of Jesus show us who Jesus really is: the divine Son of God. Each time God speaks to us clearly telling us that the human Jesus is the Son of God: "This is my Son!" God leaves no doubt that Jesus Christ is God's Son! From Christmas to Easter, we can be certain of this truth, and carry that belief all the days of our lives!

This year, the Ash Wednesday service will be at Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church in McAlisterville at 7:00 PM on February 26. The message will be delivered by Bishop Collins of the Upper Susquehanna Synod. The meaning of Ash Wednesday is a bit somber in that we are entering the season of Lent and are preparing for the Passion of our Lord. Nonetheless, let this be a prominent time of gathering at Trinity as children of a Risen Jesus. While this is a church service sponsored by the Lutheran congregations of Juniata County, all folks are welcome; this is a great opportunity to invite our neighbors.

Speaking of inviting others to join our celebration of Jesus and his life, consider open invitations throughout the year to neighbors, friends, newcomers and all those whose lives you touch! Please keep all those near you in your thoughts and prayers. May we all give prayers of thanksgiving for the blessings and gifts which God provides for all of us! May we share the blessings with others, older, younger, near and far! May we love those like us and those not like us as Jesus loves each of us!

May the love of Christ and the closeness of the Holy Spirit be with us all!


## ORCHERY EVENT
