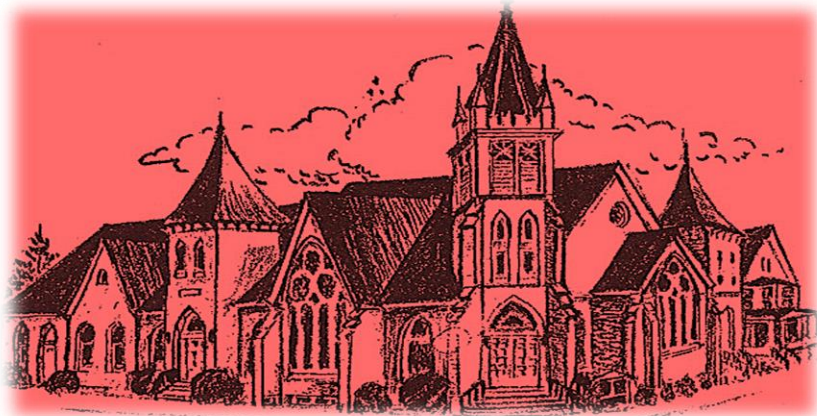

THE VOICE OF THE VICAR

Dear Messiah Family,

May the blessings of God the Creator, Jesus Christ our Lord, and The Holy Spirit be with you all!

We celebrate during February the season of Epiphany. This year Epiphany lasts through seven Sundays until we reach Transfiguration Sunday on February 27. Take a moment to read the account of this transfiguration in Luke 9:28-36. Read this to discover which disciples were with Jesus and who appeared and spoke with Jesus on the mountain.

Mark your calendars for during the months of March and April we celebrate the season of Lent. Wednesday, March 2 is Ash Wednesday, the first of Wednesday evening services at Messiah which will conclude on Wednesday April 6. Make note that Palm Sunday is April 10 and Easter is April 17.

Regarding the "Book of the Month" studies, the readings in January concluded the Psalms. As you think back through this book, select your five most favorite Psalms. Write them down somewhere, perhaps in a journal, at least their numbers if not the complete Psalm. Make some notes as to what caught your interest in selecting those particular ones.

As for a new book for February, begin reading through the Gospel of Luke. There are 24 chapters so let's divide this by eleven as we have approximately 11 weeks between now and Easter. That means you want to read one chapter by Wednesday each week and the next chapter before Sunday.

Additionally, we have copies of *Grace Unbounded: Devotions for Lent 2022* by Priscilla Austin (Contributor). *Grace Unbounded* provides daily devotions for each day from Ash Wednesday to the Vigil of Easter (traditionally known as Holy Saturday). These are available on the tables in the Sunday school room and from Judy in the church office. We are planning on holding a discussion group during Lent to share thoughts and insights regarding these devotions. Please think of joining us then.

Let us continue to serve others in need during these extreme times of grief, sickness, loneliness, and struggles. Remain steadfast in your faith in the Love of Jesus to bring to others consolation, attention, happiness, and the peace that passes worldly understanding. Share the message of hope with others around you. Find ways to carry God's Love to others whom we must for now remain physically at a distance but can and must embrace with our spiritual arms and our souls.

May the Lord be with you all!

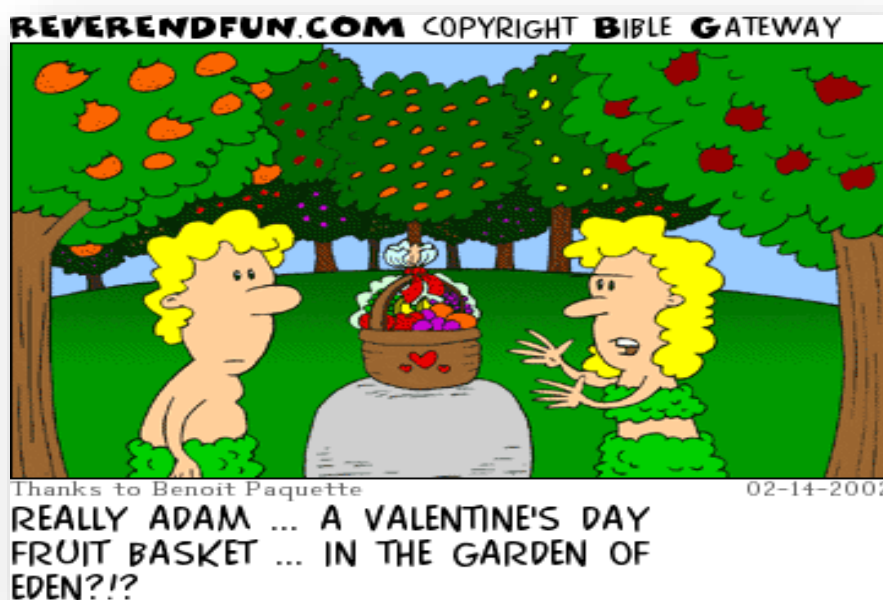
FEBRUARY 4-5, 2022: GROW in the Snow

All youth in 6-12th grade and their youth leaders are invited to attend this synod youth

retreat. The theme of this year's will be around scripture. Experience your Creator, play winter games and find refreshment in the peace of camp in winter. The retreat is from Friday night to Saturday afternoon, but there is an option for youth and leaders to come just for the day on Saturday. Cost is \$66 (whole program) or \$45 (Saturday only). Each registered group should provide one adult (21 or over) for every seven youth and at least one adult for each gender represented. CAMPERSONS WANTED: This year, we'll have a Summer Preview Party as part of our GROW in the Snow weekend and invite campersons and anyone else to come to hear about the program offerings for 2022. Join us at 3:30 p.m. on February 5 at the Evergreen Center for the preview and then campersons will be given additional information to share with their congregations. Expect to be here for an hour and fifteen minutes. What's a camperson? A camperson is a liaison between camp and your congregations. They are ambassadors, regularly promoting camp news. Each synod congregation is asked to send a representative to this event to learn more about Mount Luther. Another benefit is that campersons will get Camel Bucks to the camp store for all those from their church who attend summer camp.

MOUNT LUTHER SUNDAY: The Upper Susquehanna Synod Council designated that Transfiguration Sunday each year is "Mount Luther Sunday" to help promote outdoor ministries in the synod. Members of USS congregations are encouraged to celebrate outdoor ministries on February 27, 2022. Mount Luther is an extension of our ministry together and we hope all congregations will join in celebrating outdoor ministries by offering financial support, keeping the camp staff in prayer, and by participating in the numerous events and activities this ministry offers. 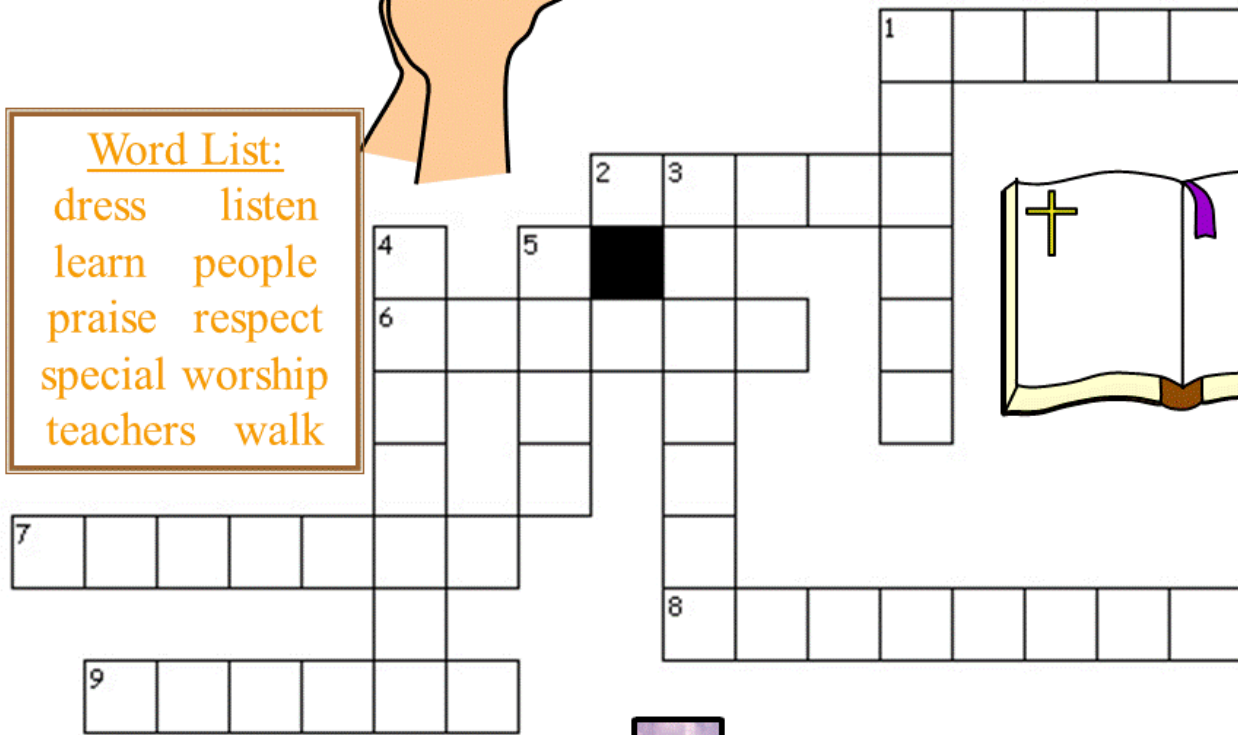

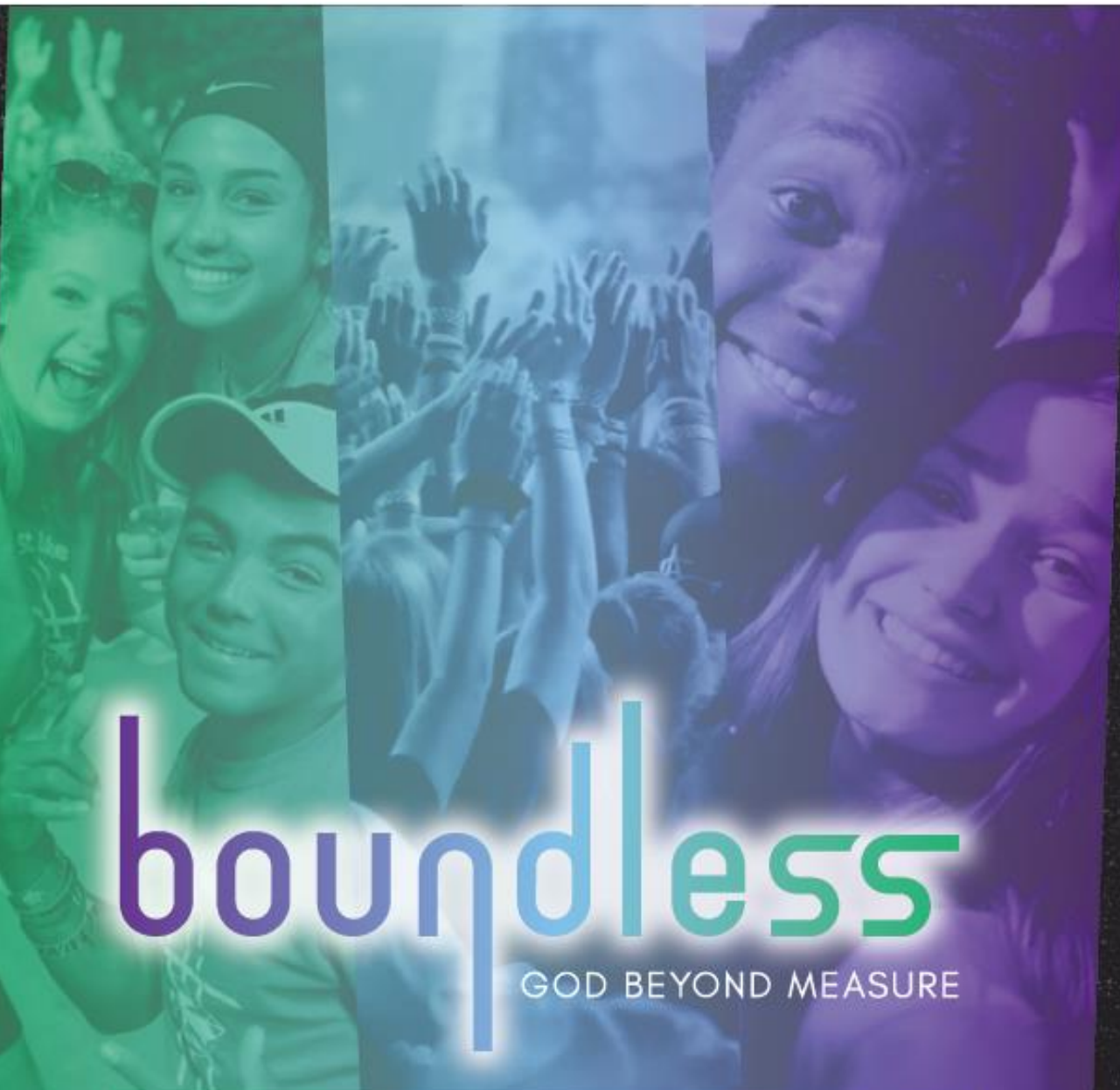
