VOICE OF THE VICAR

Dear Messiah Family,

May the blessings of God the Creator, Jesus Christ our Lord, and The Holy Spirit be with you all!

We celebrate during March the season of Lent. Wednesday, March 2 is Ash Wednesday, the first of Wednesday evening services at Messiah which will conclude on Wednesday April 6. Make note that Palm Sunday is April 10 and Easter is April 17.

We still have copies of <u>Grace Unbounded</u>: <u>Devotions for Lent 2022</u> by Priscilla Austin (Contributor). <u>Grace Unbounded</u> provides daily devotions for each day from Ash Wednesday to the Vigil of Easter (traditionally known as Holy Saturday). These are available on the tables in the Sunday school room and from Judy in the church office. We will be holding a discussion group during Lent to share thoughts and insights regarding these devotions. Please think of joining us.

Regarding the "Book of the Month" studies, during March, we are reading through the Gospel of Luke. To review, there are 24 chapters. You should read one chapter by Wednesday each week and the next chapter before Sunday. You should now be reading chapter 9 or 10 at the beginning of March. The Gospel lessens this year are from the Gospel of Luke. You may want to read ahead of re once more the chapters for these Sundays in March: March 6 – Luke 4; March 13 & 20 – Luke 13; and March 27 – Luke 15.

By the way, who were the disciples who went onto the mountain with Jesus and witnessed his transfiguration? Who appeared and spoke with Jesus on the mountain?

One more special event during March: on March 13, Chad Hershberger, director of Camp Mt Luther, will be with us. He will provide a Camp presentation and discussion during Sunday school as well as an appearance during our worship service. All children and their parents are encouraged to attend even if you are not planning on going to camp this year. Also, as members of a congregation which provides wonderful support for Camp Mt Luther, please come and join the throng that morning.

Let us continue to serve others in need during these extreme times of grief, sickness, loneliness, and struggles. Remain steadfast in your faith in the Love of Jesus to bring to others consolation, attention, happiness, and the peace that passes worldly understanding. Share the message of hope with others around you. Find ways to carry God's Love to others whom we must for now remain physically at a distance but can and must embrace with our spiritual arms and our souls.

I. What is Lent:



- Lent is a forty-day liturgical season that initiates the most sacred part of the Christian year.
 - Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and concludes on the <u>Great Vigil</u> <u>of Easter</u>.
 - Sundays are not included in the forty-day count because every Sunday is a joyful celebration of our Lord's resurrection.
 - During Lent, Christians meditate on the great paschal mystery -the salvation God won for us sinners by the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Grant peace and healing as you lead us from war to peace. Guide leaders with your wisdom and turn our eyes to your mercy in this time of destruction.








