THE PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

Dear Messiah Family,

May the blessings of God the Creator, Jesus Christ our Lord, and The Holy Spirit be with you all!

We continue to celebrate the season of Epiphany on the first Sunday of February. This year Epiphany lasts through Transfiguration Sunday on February 11. Take a moment to read the account of this transfiguration in Mark 9:2-9. Read this to discover which disciples were with Jesus and who appeared and spoke with Jesus on the mountain. Imagine for a moment what these disciples thought and why they made the suggestions they made. Verse 7 reads: Then a cloud overshadowed them, and from the cloud there came a voice, "This is my Son, the Beloved; listen to him!" The word 'listen' means for us 'to hear' as well as 'to <u>heed</u>' and 'to <u>obey</u>.' Therefore, we are commanded to do more than simply hearing the words and messages, we are to understand, adhere to His teachings as well as to walk in His ways.

Mark your calendars during the months of February and March as we celebrate the season of Lent. Ash Wednesday, February 14 is the first of Wednesday evening services at Messiah, Aldersgate, and St. Stephen's. The lessons will focus on the physical wounds of Christ inflicted by scourging, the crown of thorns, the nails in his hands and feet and the Roman spear in his side. Check the schedule in the newsletter for the specific details of the messages brought by Pastor Mindy Petrovcic, Pastor Rick Adams, and me. We will complete Holy Week with Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services.

Let us continue to serve others in need during times of grief, sickness, loneliness, and struggles. Remain steadfast in your faith in the Love of Jesus to bring to others consolation, attention, happiness, and the peace that passes worldly understanding. Share the message of hope with others around you. Find ways to carry God's Love to others who are isolated, alone, and unsure of their place in our community and society. Embrace each of them with our spiritual arms and our souls.




