

PONDERINGS OF THE PASTOR

Dear Messiah Family,

May the blessings of God the Creator, Jesus Christ our Lord, and The Holy Spirit be with you all!

Many of us make New Year's resolutions. Some resolutions are kept but most eventually fall by the wayside and are forgotten. Let us resolve to follow a path this summer of reconnecting with others as we move forward from the times of isolation and reduced personal contact with others in our congregation and community. In this newsletter and in the weekly Sunday bulletins you will find lists of shut-ins and those in need of prayers. The act of lifting up in prayers others and their needs is a wonderful way to put into practice our faith in Christ through the Holy Spirit. Pray often.

From the Augsburg Confession: "Articles of Faith and Doctrine: Concerning God: In the first place, it is with one accord taught and held, following the decree of the Council of Nicea, that there is one divine essence which is named God and truly is God. But there are three persons in the same one essence, equally powerful, equally eternal: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. All three are one divine essence, eternal, undivided, unending, of immeasurable power, wisdom, and goodness, the creator and preserver of all visible and invisible things. What is understood by the word "person" is not a part nor a quality in another but that which exists by itself, as the Fathers once used the word concerning this issue."

One of the major concepts of our beliefs is contained in the sentence, "All three are one divine essence, eternal, undivided, unending, of immeasurable power, wisdom, and goodness, the creator and preserver of all visible and invisible things." As is stated in the first verse of the first chapter of John, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." Thus the Trinity is one and inseparable; always was, is, and always will be, immortal!

Watch for more on the Trinity in future letters.

May the blessings of God the Creator, Jesus Christ our Lord, and The Holy Spirit be with you all!


